

Two years ago, I was preparing for my second mission conference as a new missionary. There were still so many unknowns and so much to do. In many ways, I felt completely unprepared for the task ahead but knew that God's timing is perfect. If He was opening doors, it was the perfect time to walk through them, and I could do so with complete confidence that He would take care of every need and every detail... which He did! His strength has been made perfect in my weakness, and He has been glorified!!

God has used the ministry of deputation to grow me so much, but there is still much growing to do! As I look ahead to ministry in Liberia, I can see God's preparation in so many ways. He is preparing my heart and mind to respond with the right attitude and right perspective. He is showing me my strengths and weaknesses and how He can use both for His purpose and His glory. I wouldn't trade a single day of this deputation journey for anything!

Monique has been diagnosed with **pancreatic cancer**. She has received four **chemo** treatments which seem to be **working well**. The tumor is no longer growing! We're thankful her health remains good enough to continue working for the Lord. There is an open door for her to **start a ministry** to those with **special needs** there in NY. Please pray against sickness and for wisdom, strength, and many helpers!

Liberia recently held their **presidential election**. There were 20 candidates with the **top two candidates** receiving approximately 43% each. Since neither candidate had over 50% of the vote, there is a **run-off election** scheduled for **November 14th**. Please pray the elections can be held as scheduled, that they are peaceful, fair, and honest, and that the country will continue to welcome missionaries.

There was an incident involving a missionary toward the end of September which has **led to** some anti-missionary sentiment. Please, pray the truth will be known; for missionary safety; this incident will not be detrimental to sharing the gospel; God will be glorified; and people will be saved.

Thank you for praying and partnering with me to raise the final 3% financial support. I now have 100%!! After much prayer and counsel, I have a tentative plan to leave for Liberia in late January or early February. I hadn't planned to be stateside for the holidays, but I am grateful for this time to spend with family before starting the journey of life in Liberia. There is much to be thankful for. Let us "enter into His gates with thanksgiving, and into His courts with praise: be thankful unto Him, and bless His name." (Ps. 100:4)


