Happy New Year, Friends! "...Grace be unto you, and peace, from Him which is, and which was, and which is to come..." (Revelation 1:4)

As we begin a new year, I continue to be amazed at God's wisdom, protection, and provision. The transition from 2022 to 2023 has been a busy and exciting one!

In the later part of November, God began opening doors for me to **rent an apartment** in Liberia. After prayer and discussion, my authorities and I were sure it was God's will for me to go ahead and rent this place. As of **December 1**st, I have a home and office in Liberia! Many people have expressed concern for my safety on the field. This apartment is a **great place**, at a **good price**, in one of the **safer areas** of Monrovia. The landlady is a Christian and has been very easy to work with. My team mate, Monique, lives right next door and has an office space right below me. We are excited to be neighbors and colaborers in Liberia! I'm also happy that my home isn't sitting empty in my absence. It is **already being used for ministry!** It has been used as a quest house for other missionaries and has provided storage

for missionaries in transition from one area of the country to another. I'm sure God has many more plans for this space, and I can't wait to find out what they are!

I had very few meetings in **December**, but there was still **a lot of work accomplished**! A **man** at one of my meetings, **surrendered to full-time ministry**. I have been in communication with my team mates and other


missionaries to get a better idea of what will be needed to live and minister in Liberia. They have given me great suggestions about things I will need, which things to get here versus there, and how to ship it in the most reliable, cost-effective way. Several people have already donated supplies for the work in Liberia. Some helpers and I have been **working to get those things sorted, cleaned, organized, and packed**. I've had several people tell me to send a list of needs, so they can help purchase or donate those items. Lord willing, I will be sending out that list in the near future.

I hit the ground running in **January**. I've had meetings every Sunday and one Wednesday this month and had the **opportunity to teach Kindergarten** at my old school for a few days! It was an extra special bloosing to be invited to four of my supporting abundant to teach their shilders and give an in parent

blessing to **be invited to four of my supporting churches** to teach their children and give an in-person update. I also had the opportunity to **present in a new church** and **teach their ladies**' Sunday school class. I never know from one day to the next what my schedule is going to look like. There was a time when that would have thrown me into a panic, but I've come to enjoy **waiting on God and following His lead** – step-by-step and moment-by-moment.

Many have asked me when I'm leaving for the field. As most of you know, it was my prayer to be on the field by the end of January. God said "no" to that request, and I am content with His answer. His timing is best. As I wait for Him to give me the "green light", my church and I are **planning my commissioning service, gathering necessary paperwork,** and **preparing things to be shipped**. I'll be sending a shipment when I get to 80% monthly support.

Thank you for your prayers regarding financial support. God has continued to bless, and I am happy to report that I now have **over 79% of my needed support**. In addition to the monthly support, God has provided an apartment, all the funds needed to move to Liberia, and a good start on the funds needed to purchase a vehicle. As I look back over the last year, I can't help but marvel at God's provision and blessing. Raising over 65% support in 12 months has only one explanation – **God has done it**!!!

Vehicle Fund
